<b>Name:</b>	John Creager	
<b>Home in 1810 (City, County, State):</b>	Washington county, Kentucky	
<b>Free White Persons - Males - Under 10:</b>	2	Wyatt Hester Creager , age 3, b. 1807. William Sawyer Creager, age 2, b. 1808.
<b>Free White Persons - Males - 16 thru 25:</b>	1	Unknown male, born 1785-1794. John & Peggy married 1798 per KY marriage records. Brother or cousin of John or Peggy?
<b>Free White Persons - Males - 26 thru 44 :</b>	1	John George Creager, age 39 , b. 1771.
<b>Free White Persons - Females - Under 10:</b>	1	Unknown female, born 1800-1810
<b>Free White Persons - Females - 10 thru 15:</b>	1	Sarah Creager , age 11, b. 1799.
<b>Free White Persons - Females - 16 thru 25:</b>	3	Unknown females, born 1785-1794. John & Peggy married 1798 per KY marriage records. Sisters or cousins of John or Peggy? One could be wife of unknown male, aged 16-25.
<b>Free White Persons - Females - 26 thru 44:</b>	1	Margaret 'Peggy', age 30, b. abt 1780.
<b>Number of Household Members Under 16:</b>	4	
<b>Number of Household Members Over 25:</b>	2	
<b>Number of Household Members:</b>	10
